## DECREE

**of the Ministry of Finance of the Slovak  
Republic**

of 12 March 1996

**on prices of special equipment**

The Ministry of Finance of the Slovak Republic, pursuant to Article 22 of Act of the National Council of the Slovak Republic No. 18/1996 Coll. on prices (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), establishes:

### Article 1

(1) The rules for price negotiation, application of price regulation and price control in the field of special equipment also apply to products, performances, purchase of licences, services and work carried out within the framework of research, development, production and repair of weaponry-related products (hereinafter referred to as "weaponry goods"), which are produced and sold domestically and are exclusively intended to ensure the defence capability and security of the State.<sup>1)</sup>

(2) The prices of weaponry goods are subject to a generally binding legal regulation,<sup>2)</sup> unless otherwise provided by this Decree.

### Article 2

(1) An agreement on the price of weaponry goods shall mean a price agreed in writing or a written agreement on the method by which the price is created.

(2) When negotiating the price of weaponry goods, in addition to the data specified in Article 3 of the Act, the following data are also binding:

- a) the name of the goods according to the valid technical conditions or according to the terms of reference,
- b) the numerical classification code,<sup>1)</sup>
- c) the unit of measure,<sup>3)</sup>
- d) the quality conditions according to the valid military standard, technical conditions and according to the specific requirements of the buyer,
- e) the delivery conditions according to the specific requirements of the buyer expressed in the contract, according to the technical conditions or according to the valid military standard.

(3) The price at which weaponry goods<sup>4)</sup> produced with incomplete use of the capacities of single-purpose production and other facilities are offered is based on economically justified costs<sup>5)</sup> for production,

procurement, processing and circulation and on a reasonable profit margin.<sup>6)</sup> As a basis for negotiating the price of weaponry goods, a calculation of the price at which the weaponry goods are offered is submitted to the buyer.

**Article 3**

(1) Price records for the purposes of negotiating prices for weaponry goods also include documents containing

- a) binding data pursuant to Article 2(2) and economically justified costs and a reasonable profit margin pursuant to Article 2(3),
- b) the amount of the agreed price and its calculation including the calculation of the price of weaponry goods when the capacities of single-purpose production and other weaponry-related facilities are not fully utilised.

(2) Price records and price calculations are kept under the name "weaponry goods", separately from price records and price calculations for other goods.

**Article 4**

Prices of weaponry goods are stated exclusively in the offer price lists of weaponry goods. The seller shall provide price lists of weaponry goods to persons authorised to purchase weaponry goods upon request. The provisions of a special regulation<sup>7)</sup> are not affected by this. Prices of weaponry goods are not stated in price lists together with the prices of other goods, except in cases where weaponry goods are released for sale on the domestic market or for export.

**Article 5**

This Decree shall come into effect on 1 April 1996.
